

2012 JUNIOR WOMAN'S CLUB SPELLING BEE

The GFWC Junior Woman's Club of Cranford would like to invite all fourth and fifth grade students who attend school in Cranford to participate in our annual Spelling Bee.

The fourth grade competition will be held on January 25th at 7:00 p.m. at the Cranford Community Center, 220 Walnut Avenue. We ask that all of the fourth grade students report to the second floor of the Community Center at 6:45 p.m.

The fifth grade competition will be held on January 26th at 7:00 pm at the Community Center. We ask that all of the fifth grade students report to the second floor of the Community Center at 6:45 p.m.

Ten fourth grade students and ten fifth grade students will advance to the finals. The finals will take place after the fifth grade competition on January 26th at approximately 8:00 p.m. All students participating in the final round should report to the Community Center at 7:45 p.m. The top three spellers from the final competition will represent the club in the District Spelling Bee in February. The top three spellers from the District Spelling Bee will represent the District at the State Spelling Bee in New Brunswick.

Changes due to inclement weather will be announced on Channel 35. If the fourth grade Bee on January 25th is cancelled, it will be held on February 1st. A snow date has been set for the fifth grade and the final competition for February 2nd.

Each student will receive a numbered nametag to determine the order for the competition. There will be a pronouncer to announce each word to the contestants. The child will pronounce the word, spell it and then pronounce it again. There will be a panel of two judges present. The Practice List and other Club Bee materials are on the website www.JerseyJuniors.com. The official rules and a practice word list are attached to this letter. Please note that the practice list does not include all the words that will be used in the competition. Each child will receive a certificate of participation in the Spelling Bee.
