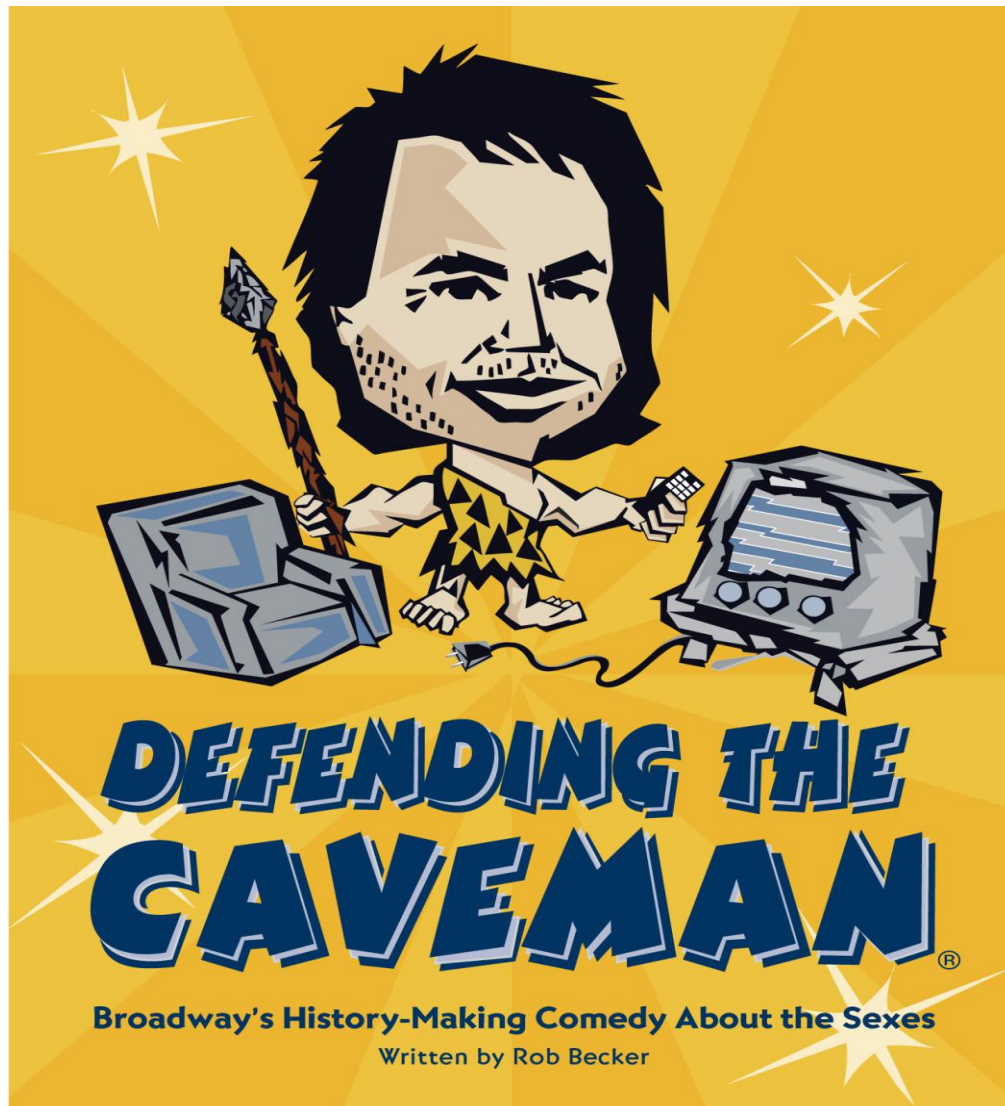


The Cranford Fund for Educational Excellence in partnership with **The Clark Education Fund** invites you to join us for a night of comedy....
