POLICY: PROGRAM FOR DISAFFECTED PUPILS

The Cranford Board of Education wishes to address a population of special students in our schools. A disaffected pupil is a pupil who has instructional needs that are not being met by the regular instructional program and who is performing well below his/her social or academic capacity.

The Chief School Administrator shall develop a plan which makes provisions for identifying disaffected pupils and providing them with an appropriate educational program and service. Due to their characteristics, disaffected pupils may require educational programs or services different from those offered or delivered in the regular classroom.

The way in which this program is administered in each school shall be appropriate to the grade level of the pupil involved.
