**POLICY: MID-TERM AND FINAL EXAMINATIONS - CRANFORD HIGH SCHOOL**

It is the philosophy of the Cranford Board of Education that mid-term and final examinations are a vital and necessary part of the educational process because they serve the following purposes:

1. Provide a means to test student understanding and mastery of the major concepts, facts, goals and objectives of each course.
2. Provide the college-bound student experience in preparing for taking a final examination.
3. Provide all students experience in a formal testing experience realizing that pre-employment and career entry and advancement testing is becoming increasingly prevalent.
4. Provide teacher with important feedback needed to evaluate student learning and understanding on a longer term basis than that tested by the usual chapter or unit test.

Therefore, the Cranford Board of Education directs the Chief School Administrator and administrative staff to create administrative regulations and procedures which will lead to the institution of an appropriate examination process.
