POLICY: HOMEWORK

The Cranford Board of Education recognizes that homework is a vital part of the learning process in that the student, while working independently, use concepts, taught in the classroom and therefore reinforces the classroom instruction.

In a K-12 school system, the wide diversity of student ages, abilities and programs makes a specific homework policy unworkable. Therefore, the Board is making this general policy statement regarding homework. We feel it is important and should be a daily activity whenever suitable.

The Superintendent is directed to develop and disseminate a set of homework guidelines for each grade level. These procedures shall allow maximum teacher flexibility, but still assure a constant and appropriate assignment of homework to each child throughout the Cranford School district.

When the procedures are completed, they should be attached to this policy and copies circulated for maximum understanding of all.
