POLICY: SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

The regular curriculum of the district's school is designed to accomplish the district's educational goals and objectives for a thorough and efficient system of education for all pupils.

When necessary, the regular program shall be altered or supplemented or other means used to provide for the identified needs of the following students:

- A. The classifiable educationally disabled
- B. The gifted and talented
- C. Those requiring remedial programs
- D. The disaffected, alienated and disruptive
- E. Pregnant pupils
- F. Pupils requiring home instruction
- G. The physically disabled
- H. Those with limited English proficiencies
- 1. Those requiring Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act Services
