ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION

SPECIAL EDUCATION:
TRANSITION FROM EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAMS TO PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS

Children with disabilities participating in early intervention programs assisted under IDEA Part C who will participate in preschool programs under N.J.A.C. 6A:14-1.1 et seq. experience a smooth transition, and an Individual Education Program (IEP) has been developed and is being implemented according to N.J.A.C. 6A:14-3.3(e).

Procedure For Child Study Team (CST) Member Attendance At The Transition Planning Conference

1. The Cranford Public Schools will make available a CST member to attend the transition planning conference arranged by the early intervention program when notified.
2. The Cranford Public Schools will work collaboratively with the early intervention program to eliminate barriers regarding meeting times and locations.
3. School district officials shall adhere to all procedures contained in N.J.A.C. 6A:14-1.1 et seq. for transitioning children with disabilities from early intervention programs to preschool programs.
