RE: Student-Athlete Transportation

Recently, concerns have been brought to my attention regarding students-athletes driving other student-athletes to home games and practices at our various facilities.

The logistical set up of our athletic facilities has always required that student-athletes travel to home games and practices via shuttle buses provided by the district or by personal means of transportation.

Currently, two shuttle buses are provided during the fall and spring seasons and one shuttle bus is provided during the winter season. Each shuttle makes two complete trips to assigned sites. This transportation system reaches all sites. This allows students who are late for various reasons to still make it to their games and practices.

For those whose student-athletes are choosing to be transported by another student, I would like to provide you with the New Jersey State Provisional Driver License restrictions:

*“No driving between 12:10 am and 5:00 am. Passengers must be from the driver’s household, plus one additional person. If the driver is at least 21 years old, there are no passengers or hour restrictions. Drivers cannot use cell phones, hand held video games or any other hand held electronic devices. The driver and all passengers are required to wear seat belts.”*

**Let’s make sure our student-athletes obey the law.**

If, as a parent/guardian, you do not want your child being transported by another student, encourage them to take the provided shuttle buses or arrange transportation on your own.
