All students are assigned a locker with a combination lock to secure their school supplies. Please note that due to security reasons, only school issued locks may be used on lockers. We expect that students keep lockers neat and clean. Students will be responsible for damages and may be assessed the cost of repair. If, however, students find their lockers damaged in any way, they should report it to the attendance office immediately. In addition, students will need to keep their locks for their high school years. Before they graduate or leave the high school for any other reason, the students must return their locks to us. If students lose a lock or do not return a lock, they will be assessed the replacement cost at the time of loss. This year's replacement cost is five dollars. I hope that this information is helpful to you. Do not hesitate to call us if you need further assistance.

All students are to report for the first day of school on September 12th to their homeroom by 8:15 a.m. The first day of school is a 12:30 dismissal for grades 10-12. All freshmen and new students will participate in our orientation from 12:30-2:55.
