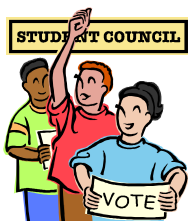
**Stage Crew** - Students in grades 6-8 are eligible to join the Stage Crew. The Stage Crew prepares the stage for the school musical and other school performances.

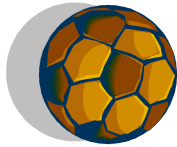
